Now, the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India vide letter no. L. 11011/1/2020-EP-1 (Part-1) dated 19/03/2021, has reduced the percentile criteria in the AIAPGET-2020, in order to be eligible for admission into ASU & H PG courses for the academic session 2020-21. As such, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum 40th percentile in AIAPGET-2020. However, in respect of the candidates belonging to Schedule Caste (SC), Schedule Tribe (ST) and Other Backward Classes (OBC), the minimum mark shall be 30th percentile. In respect of the candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Right of Person with Disabilities Act, 2016, the minimum mark shall be 35th percentile for Un-Reserved (UR) and 30th percentile for SC/ST/OBC.

Hence, application are invited from the eligible candidates as per the above said letter of the Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India vide no.
